Registration fees for the week-end (2 days):

Pro/Expert - \$110/class on pre registration - \$135 at the gate

All other classes - \$90/class on pre registration - \$115 at the gate

Mini MX:

\$40 registration at the gate from 5:00 PM to 6:00 PM

Admission for spectators:

Everyone must pay their admission to enter the facility.

Admissions will pay back to racers at the registration.

Note: Pit Bikes forbidden in the pit areas (Pit Bikes are only allowed for Saturday evening racing use).

Tech Requirements:

Safety Wire:

All fill/drain plugs

Any bolt that if removed would release fluid (water pump) Front caliper bolts

Foot peg protectors

Hand guards

Fluids:

Must replace antifreeze in radiators with water/water wetter; Catch Can; Any overflow/vent lines must be rerouted into a secured, heat resistant container to prevent fluids from spilling onto the track

Overall condition of bike must be acceptable

Rider's equipment:

- full face or motocross helmet with goggle
- 1 piece or 2 piece leather suit or motocross gear
- motocross boots
- gloves

Accommodations:

Free overnight pitting area will be provided for racers on Friday and Saturday night (NO FIRE, NO PIT BIKE-MOTORCYCLE or ATV; engines off please)

Gate closing: the gate will be closed after 10:00 PM on Friday.

Participants can camp before the bridge near the river after 10:00 PM.

The gate will be open at 7:30 Saturday morning and will be open until Sunday evening.
